TIPS FOR APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS, BURSARIES AND AWARDS

Getting started:

Start early.

Look around: the award for you may not be listed in the first place you look.

Check general scholarship websites, university/college websites.

Know your goals and how the award will help you achieve them.

Completing the Application:

Read eligibility requirements carefully. Apply only if you are eligible and make sure you demonstrate how you meet the criteria.

If you have questions, ASK!

Be yourself

Follow instructions.

Don't leave items blank. Include all requested attachments.

In your essays, go for quality, not quantity. Essays are usually your best opportunity to make your application stand out so give them the attention they deserve. Be personal and be specific. Know your strengths and don't be afraid to advertise them. Present yourself as a well-rounded student. Start with making a list of everything you were involved in. These questions may help to guide you:

Were you on the honour roll?

Are you in French Immersion or taking honours classes?

What extra-curricular activities were you involved in at school? Sports, Plays, Clubs, Student Council, Teens for Change?

Did you receive any awards for these activities or a service award?

Did you take music or dance lessons? What grade or level did you achieve?

Do you teach? E.g. Skating, swimming

Did you travel abroad during school to study or volunteer?

Did you have a part-time job? What life skills are you learning?

E.g. Self-discipline, taking initiative, balancing priorities, etc.

Proofread your application and any essays. Have someone else proofread them too. Choose references carefully and make sure they can describe why you are a good candidate for that award. If possible, choose individuals who can speak to different aspects of your qualifications. For example, one reference might be a teacher another reference might be your boss or former boss. Make copies of everything you send. Apply for all awards for which you are eligible, but tailor letters to suit each award. Apply on time, or better yet, early. Email or phone the organization about a week after you have submitted your application to make sure your application has been received.

If you are offered an award, send a thank you letter. A personal letter is better than an email.

Scholarships and Financial Assistance FAQ Sheet

Q: What types of scholarships are available?

A: Entrance scholarships

- No application needed; university will offer this scholarship along with your offer of admission
- Based completely on your academic average (your best five Grade 12 30-1 or 31 level courses; including those required specifically for your program)
- E.g. 80-84.9% = \$1000, 85-89%=\$1500, 90-94.9%=\$2000

B: Academic/merit scholarships and academic/merit scholarships with community service/leadership

- Offered through universities, colleges, community organizations, businesses, your parents' workplaces and unions
- Application is required; it is your responsibility to obtain the application form
- Application forms are available by contacting the institutions themselves or through the institutions' websites. A limited number of applications are available through the Guidance Office
- Note that some scholarships are done through nomination only. In order to be nominated for a particular scholarship, see your Guidance Counsellor
- Some scholarships are based solely on your academic average while others combine the average with community service, leadership experience, work experience, etc.

C: Community/Leadership scholarships

- Offered through community organizations
- Applications required
- Application forms are available by contacting the institutions themselves or through the institution's websites. A limited number of applications are available through the Guidance Office
- Note that some scholarships are done through nomination only. In order to be nominated for a particular scholarship, see your Guidance Counsellor
- Usually based solely on community, leadership experience, however, some may ask for your academic record

D: Athletic scholarships

- Generally, universities will "discover" and approach you
- No application necessary

Q: When should I start looking into scholarships? When should I start to apply?

A: The answer to these questions is: as soon as possible. Deadlines for scholarships vary, and some scholarship deadlines may be as early as November.

Q: Should I apply even if my academic average is not that high?

A: Yes. Applying for scholarships is FREE. It takes, in some cases, a lot of time and effort. The application may require an essay, reference letters, transcripts, etc. You have nothing to lose! You have a lot to gain!

Q: How many scholarships can I apply for?

A: As many as you want! However, a small minority of scholarships may take into consideration if you have received other types of financial assistance, including other grants, bursaries, or scholarships.

Q: What is involved in scholarship applications?

A: Generally, you will be required to provide your transcript, your community service, leadership experience, part-time work, answers to specific questions pertaining to the scholarship in question, reference letters, and possibly a financial profile.

NOTE: For references, ensure that you ask for permission and/or provide ample time for your referee to write a letter. Also, it is advised that you provide your referee with a resume or an outline of your experience and accomplishments.

Q: What other types of financial assistance is available besides scholarships?

A: There are a lot of options. Some common sources of financial aid are: Alberta Student Loan Program is an interest-free (while at university or college) loan provided by the government. For more information visit <http://alis.alberta.ca/ps/fo/pay/loans-grants.html>

BURSARIES: Free money given to students with proven financial need. You can apply once you are accepted into university or college

Contact the Financial Aid Office of the institution you are planning to attend for more information on these and other forms of financial assistance.

Some Final Tips:

- Build up your community, work, leadership and teamwork experience
- Check the Guidance Bulletin board periodically for updates
- Make an appointment with your Guidance Counsellor
