***Schulich Leader Scholarships* are open to all graduating high school students across Canada who have an interest in pursuing Science, Technology, Engineering or Math at one of our partner universities.**

In order to become a *Schulich Leader* and receive the scholarship, a student must first be selected by their high school as a *Schulich Leader Nominee*.

Holy Trinity can submit only one nominee*

Nominees must possess at least two of three criteria:

1. Academic excellence
2. Outstanding community, business or entrepreneurial leadership
3. Financial need**

Nominees must be enrolling in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Math degree at one of our partner universities.

Nominees must be graduating from their high school in the 2014/2015 academic year

Nominees must be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.

Nominee Deadline is February 2nd, 2015

Ask your guidance counsellor to consider submitting your information in January 2015 to represent your school.

To be eligible for consideration of the Award, the following two criteria apply:

- The Grade 12 student must have the intent on becoming a teacher and plan to enter a teacher preparation institution in Alberta directly upon graduation.
- The student must submit a 1000-word essay describing why education is their chosen field of study. The essay should also describe the student's vision of a day in the life of a teacher in the classroom with a focus on how s/he would engage learners.
